We also recommend that you go to the credit report agencies and create a **lock** and freeze action to protect yourself.

We are discussing possible ways to enhance security in our community. One of them is to install security cameras that send the information to a cloud system and is readily available to the authorities. Another one is to study the possibility of installing security gates. This project would need the approval of the members. Another one is the possibility of getting locked mailboxes (not a

very feasible option) or mail banks placed on strategic sites throughout the community.
